The **Art Music Fund** exists to commission new work that is innovative, displays professional compositional craft and represents a benchmark of excellence in its field. These works must have **confirmed** plans and partners to ensure the work is presented multiple times with the intention to create a long artistic life for the work and by extension its composer.

This year the Art Music Fund will be awarding \$7,500AUD grants to 11 successful applicants (9 from Australia, 2 from New Zealand).

All applications are assessed against the following criteria:

- **Innovation**
- **Excellence & Compositional Craft**
- **Viability**
- **Reach & Impact**

Confirmation of presenting partners, and intended activity (including performance), is required in order for an application to be competitive. However, due to the uncertain landscape and ongoing impact of COVID-19, APRA AMCOS acknowledges all long-term plans require the ability to adapt to changing circumstances, and this will be reflected in the acquittal process.
